

Dragon Models has four new WWII figures coming out this month — two US soldiers and two German soldiers.

The first US soldier — **Mickey** — is the second to last of Dragon's five figure series homage to *Saving Private Ryan* series (Danny, Jim, and Richie were the first three). It's pretty obvious that this figure is styled after the character Sergeant Mike Horvath (portrayed by Tom Sizemore in the film).

This particular **Ranger** is outfitted in wool shirt, HBT green pants, molded low boots (lace up), cloth leggings, tan tankers jacket, and M1 helmet. His equipment includes the M1928 pack with meatcan pouch, wire cutters with pouch, canteen with cover, M-43 e-tool with cover, pistol belt, pistol with holster, pistol mags with pouch, and first aid pouch. His main weapon is the M1 Carbine.

The last of the *SPR* homage series however is **Cappy**. Once you check out Cappy's pics, it's pretty clear he's based on the character Private Carizzo, as depicted by Vin Diesel.

This **US Army Ranger (2nd Ranger Battalion)** comes outfitted in a M1 helmet, wool shirt, HBT trousers, M41 jacket, molded lowboots (lace up though) and cloth leggings. Other standout equipment pieces include a M5 Army assault gasmask bag, a gas detection brassard, a M1928 haversack with meatcan pouch, and a black waterproof wrapper for his M1 Garand rifle.

Dragon's first German figure, **Hermann Heiliger**, depicts a **Fallschirmjäger** within FJR 3, 1.Fallschirmjäger-Division during the **Battle for Cassino, 1944**. If you missed out on getting earlier Fallschirmjägers, or are just now getting into WWII German figure collecting, this is a great starter **Luftwaffe** figure.

He comes outfitted in the standard issue M40 Fliegerbluse tunic, Fallschirmjäger trousers, splinter pattern camo jump smock, front lace jump boots (molded), and Fallschirmjäger jump helmet (with a nice scrim netting for added camo).

His gear is all there too - Luftwaffe blue bread bag, mess tin, water bottle, bayonet and scabbard, and brown Luftwaffen belt with buckle. Of course, he's not complete without his FG-42 Rifle and splinter camo'd ammo bandolier!

Hermann Heiliger: Fallschirmjäger

Dragon's second German figure, **Hanno Lantzman**, depicts a **Panzergranadier Officer** within 3rd SS Division **Totenkopf, Panzergranadier-Regiment 6 "Theodor Eicke"** during the **Warsaw Front operations of 1944**.

He is outfitted in a mid-war M40 tunic and M43 kielhosen, jackboots (molded), M35/40 helmet with autumn "oakleaf" camo pattern helmet cover, autumn "oakleaf" camo over-smock, and gloved hands.

His equipment consists of a Waffen SS belt with Y harness, breadbag, water bottle, mess tin, straight handle e-tool with carrier, binoculars with straps, bayonet with scabbard, and map case. Since he is an officer, he is armed with an MP-40 sub-machine gun (with single cloth ammo pouch), and a Walther P-38 pistol with holster.
